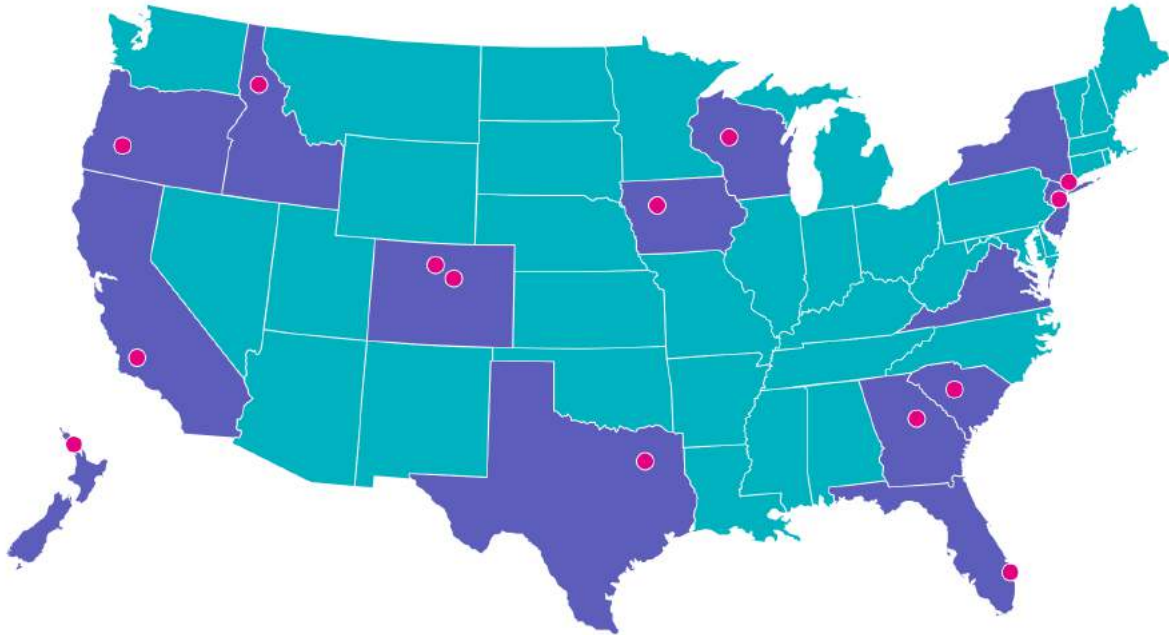

Our Core Componentents

- + Long-Term: Consistent support from no later than third grade through college completion.
- + Individualized: Outcome-driven, grade level appropriate services & programming.
- + Community Focus: Opportunities for service learning.
- + Need Based: Focus on students from low-income communities.
- + Inclusive: Including all students in a class, grade, or school, regardless of ability or performance.
- + Mentorship: Consistent relationship with a supportive adult.
- + Family engagement, regardless of language barriers.
- + Guaranteed tuition support for college.

Our Network

We currently support a network of 16 affiliates in 11 states and in New Zealand, serving over 5,000 Dreamers in every grade from Kindergarten through Post-Secondary.



THE NEED



Only **9%** of students from low-income families earn a Bachelor's degree, compared to **77%** of their high-income peers.



65% of children with parents lacking a high school diploma live in poverty.



25 Million children in U.S. public schools are low-income.

THE IMPACT

3x

Dreamers are nearly **3x more likely** to earn a Bachelor's degree than low-income peers.



90% of Dreamers complete high school, compared to **70%** of their low-income peers. This represents an additional **\$2.9 billion** in lifetime earnings.

\$1M

People with college degrees earn about **\$1 Million** more over their lifetimes than those who do not earn college degrees.
